

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Separate sealed bids for the construction of the Village of Jenera, Wastewater System; Contract A (Treatment Plant) and Contract B (Collection System) will be received by The Village of Jenera, Ohio at the Village Municipal Building, 103 S. Main Street, Jenera, OH 45841 until 12:00 p.m. (Noon, Local Time) February 15, 2008, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The scope of work to be performed for Contract A consists of the construction of a three-cell 6.7 million-gallon controlled discharge lagoon, 1,750 LF of forcemain, and 1,150 LF of 12" transfer piping, 856 LF of 15" effluent piping and all related site work. The scope of work to be performed for Contract B includes the installation of one pumping station, 8,600 LF of 8" sanitary sewer, 43 manholes, 103 service laterals, and all related restoration work. Also included in Contract B are 26 residential connections, funded through a CDBG grant, to be installed immediately following sewer system acceptance.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety. The successful bidder(s) shall be required to furnish a contract bond in the sum of not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the total contract amount. The bond shall be that of an approved surety company authorized to transact business in the State of Ohio and shall be underwritten by a surety that is listed on the most current Department of the Treasury Circular 570, "Surety Companies Acceptable on Federal Bonds".

Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio Products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the Equal Employment Opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Attention of Bidders is called to all the requirements contained in the Bid Documents, particularly the Federal Labor Standards Provisions, Davis-Bacon Wage Rates, bonding and insurance requirements and all federal and state equal opportunity provisions.
